

More Evidence of Deadly Contamination

Next we have the military bases of Guam. Each and every base has a problem with contaminants. Pesticides are on every base. The well data shows the contamination reaching the aquifer. The base data shows what the problems were on the surface. Much of the information is old. But this info shows contamination to the island and where it came from.

With the base info comes the overall contamination, things such as the superfund site location. Guam has at least 28 superfund sites, 2 NPL sites and 202 contaminated sites that they know of at this point.

At one site the Navy had to get rid of about 10,000 tons of PCB contaminated soil.

In the water quality report it shows what contaminants are still present even today.

Contaminants such as 2,3,7,8,TCDD(dioxin), 2,4,5,TP (silvex), 2,4,D, picloram (Agent White), arsenic (Agent Blue) and a host of others.

Eddie Volson tells of contaminated planes having to cool on the runways after flights in and out of the radiation clouds while they had to track the radiation. Guam was a part of the radiation zone.

This folder shows how the military was contaminating the environment of Guam. Many of these substances are still in the plumes of the aquifer or have yet to reach the aquifer per ATSDR PHA Andersen. The military hasn't even discovered all of the contamination.
